<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Phonics: Practise and constant revision of all the sounds in Level 3, 4, 5 and 6: both in reading and writing - Continue to practise: High-Frequency Words, Tricky Words and Common Exception Words. -Reading Comprehension activities: The Three Little Pigs. Compare this traditional story to alternative versions with a different twist and discuss the similarities and differences between the characters, setting, plot, and illustrations. - Grammar: Learning about adjectives, nouns and Verbs (present, past, and future tense). Learning about syllables, prefixes, and suffixes. - Speaking and listening skills: retell the story of The Three Little Pigs in different forms. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Measurement: Length and height, Mass and volume, Time - Geometry: 2D & 3D shape linked to the topic of " Materials". - Position & direction <p>Year 2 will also continue with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Multiplication and Division: 2x, 3x, 5x, 10x table - Fractions: whole, halves, quarters, thirds. 	<p><u>Everyday Materials</u></p> <p>During this topic we will look at a variety of objects and explore the different materials from which they are made. We will describe and compare the physical properties of these materials.</p> <p>We will recreate the story of The Three Little Pigs by building models of houses, using straw, twigs, bricks, and other materials and predict which material will be the most successful.</p> <p>We will work scientifically by asking questions, observing closely, and performing simple tests.</p>
